About KCCO

For 60 consecutive seasons audiences have been delighted by the sounds of the Kansas City Civic Orchestra (KCCO), the metro area’s premier community-based orchestra. KCCO is supported by over 120 volunteer musicians, our board of directors, Friends of Civic members, and generous contributions from our sponsors and donors.



KCCO concerts at Atonement Lutheran Church – which are free to the public, although donations are always appreciated – offer high quality performances as well as dynamic interaction between the conductor, the audience, and members of the orchestra. This creates a unique, comfortable atmosphere that invites engagement and enhances appreciation and enjoyment of the music.

In addition to offering family-friendly, interactive performances, KCCO also supports accessibility of music through a range of outreach programs, with a particular focus on underserved groups. Our Instrument Petting Zoo, assisted living facility performances, Young Artist Concerto Competitions, and cooperation with other community organizations such as Band of Angels are all aimed at connecting people with music. We are proud to be an active member of Kansas City’s vibrant arts community!



Outreach Programs

Our outreach programs are designed to both educate and entertain. One of our most popular events by far is the Annual Instrument Petting Zoo for children, which is now in its fifth year. The zoo gives kids the opportunity to handle, learn about, and play various instruments – from strings to horns to percussion. It’s the perfect place to cultivate the interest of budding musicians!

Educational Outreach coordinators Jennifer Mitchell and Don Goldenbaum provide additional opportunities for children to connect with music through visits to local schools. Students listen and sing along to familiar tunes, but they also get to learn about the stringed instruments they’re hearing and even try them out for themselves.



Local students aren’t the only audiences to benefit from KCCO’s unique, interactive performances. Our outreach committee also visits senior and assisted living facilities. The activity coordinator at one local facility noted that individuals who have lost the ability to communicate “light up” when they hear familiar tunes, and sometimes even sing along. She described the outreach events as “a lifeline to music, culture, and meaningful engagement.”



The Carol Chatelain Young Artist Concerto Competition is an outreach program that supports young musicians by awarding them a cash prize and the opportunity to play with the orchestra. Last year’s winner, tenth-grader Bethlehem Kelley (*left*), wowed the audience at our May 2018 concert at Helzberg Hall at the Kauffman Center for the Performing Arts. This season’s winner will also enjoy the opportunity to perform at this world-class venue.

Concerts

In our 59th season KCCO audiences enjoyed excellent performances of music by Grieg, Dvorak, Gershwin, Sousa, and more, as well as our debut performance at Helzberg Hall. Our 60th season concert themes include “American Fanfare,” “Heroes and Villains,” “Legend, Lyricism, and Ludwig,” and our annual “Sounds of the Season” concert, during which lucky raffle winners are given the opportunity to conduct the orchestra’s performance of *Sleigh Ride*. For this season’s finale we will return to fabulous Helzberg Hall for a special fundraising performance. We look forward to seeing you there!
